**Jamie Bohunicky Named 2008 Florida Dairy Farmers  
Girls' Swimmer-of-the-Year**

Gainesville (Dec. 18) --- Gainesville Buchholz senior Jamie Bohunicky was named the 2008 Florida Dairy Farmers Girls' Swimmer-of-the-Year following a final round of voting by a statewide panel of high school swimming coaches.

Bohunicky is the 17<sup>th</sup> winner of the annual award sponsored by Dairy Farmers, Inc. and the Florida Athletic Coaches Association to honor the top high school girls' swimmer for the 2008 season.

Bohunicky, who was earlier selected as the Class 3A Swimmer-of-the-Year, finished ahead of Meg Romano of St. Petersburg Northeast, the 2A Swimmer-of-the-Year and Aubrey Peacock of Jacksonville Bolles, the 1A Swimmer-of-the-Year.

Bohunicky won the 100-yard freestyle with a time of 49.24 and the 200-yard freestyle with a time of 1:46.58 at the Class 3A state championships.
