**William Federhofer and Bianca Sanon Named
Florida Dairy Farmers 2009 Tennis Players-of-the-Year**

GAINESVILLE (July 7) --- William Federhofer of Miami Dr. Krop High School and Bianca Sanon of Ft. Lauderdale St. Thomas Aquinas High School were named the 2009 Florida Dairy Farmers Boys' and Girls' Tennis Players-of-the-Year.

The winners of the 17th annual Tennis Player-of-of-the-Year Awards, sponsored by Florida Dairy Farmers, Inc. and the Florida Athletic Coaches Association, were determined in voting by a statewide panel of high school tennis coaches and prep media representatives.

Federhofer, previously named the Class 4A Player-of-the-Year won this year's boys' Class 4A state tennis title in straight sets (6-1, 6-2). Sanon was previously named the girls' Class 3A Player-of-the-Year as she captured this year's Class 2A title in straight sets (6-3, 7-6).

Coach Kelly Mulligan of Miami Gulliver Prep who was previously named the Class 2A Coach-of-the-Year won the boys' overall coaching honors after her squad won the state title with 21 points. Overall top girls' coaching honors went to Damon Halback (Class 4A Coach-of-the-Year) after his squad captured the state title with 18 points.
