**Benjamin's Harbeck and American Heritage's Carlin  
Named Florida Dairy Farmers 2009 Golf Coaches-of-the-Year**

GAINESVILLE (Dec. 18) –Toby Harbeck of North Palm Beach Benjamin High School and Mike Carlin of Plantation American Heritage High School were named the 2009 Florida Dairy Farmers Golf Coaches-of-the-Year following a final round of balloting by a statewide panel of high school golf coaches.

Harbeck, who was earlier chosen as the Class 1A Boys' Coach-of-the-Year, finished ahead of Class 2A Coach-of-the-Year Doug Peters, (Lake Mary) for the award honoring the states top boys' golf coach. His team shot a combine score of 580 on its way to capturing the 1A state title.

Carlin, who was earlier chosen as the Class 1A Girls' Coach-of-the-Year, finished ahead of Class 2A Coach-of-the-Year Frank Curl, (Lake Mary) to win the girls' coaching honor. His team totaled 590 strokes on its way to capturing the 1A state title.
