Explanation of Story:

Our school is in its first year of the FUTP60 program and since it has started there have been many positive changes in our school environment. Our biggest success with the program is obtaining a cart through the FUTP60 funding to help expand our breakfast service. The cafeteria is on the opposite side of the school campus that the students enter from. Many enjoy spending time in the courtyard rather than the cafeteria with their peers in the morning. Our cafeteria is also limited on space which makes it hard for so many students to come and enjoy breakfast at one time. Prior to applying for the grant we surveyed our students to see if we put a breakfast cart in the courtyard if they would participate in breakfast. We also asked the type of items they would like to see on the cart. The students were very interested in the new cart and were ready to participate.

We obtained funding for the cart and put our plans in action. Our FUTP60 student team created morning announcements, posters and a short video for our website to promote the new program. Those forms of communication are continuing with nutrition education messages about the items being served and the important health benefits.

The cart and the student work has been in place for three months and we have seen consistent participation. Due to this additional breakfast location we doubled our participation numbers. Students are making time for the most important meal of the day and really enjoying it!
